2016 Membership Qualifications

Farmer/Grower: Eligible farmers who grow or raise foods or other agricultural products in the Northern Tier Region. Farmers and growers include; orchards, CSA’s, plants, nurseries, Christmas trees, fiber producers, maple, honey, poultry, livestock and dairy.

Farm Markets: Eligible farm markets feature foods or other agricultural products grown in the Northern Tier Region. Markets can use BFBL materials to promote market only. Vendors must join individually. Farm markets include farmer’s markets, individual market vendors and seasonal farm stands.

Businesses: Eligible businesses include restaurants, bakeries, wineries, retail grocers & butchers.

Restaurants: At least two menu items must feature locally produced ingredients and be identified with signage.

Bakeries: Local ingredients must be promoted (minimum of two).

Wineries: “Native to Region’ wine license. Must use and own fruit or purchase fruit within the region.

Grocers/Retailers: Locally produced foods must be displayed and labeled. A minimum of 10 products available.

Butchers: Must offer local meats for sale and identify farm source with signage.

Cheese & Other Food Processors: Primary ingredients must be locally grown. Primary market must be within the Northern Tier Region.
